RULES

1. Prize money for 1st Place is guaranteed. Prize money for 2nd Place through 10th Place is an estimate based on the number of boats participating.
2. All boats must check in at the designated site by an assigned flight time or be disqualified.
3. A Tournament Official must check live wells and boats prior to the start of the tournament.
4. Rules will be read prior to the tournament start. One contestant from each boat must be present.
5. Maximum two (2) contestants per boat. Single contestants are allowed.
6. Tournament hours will be from safe daylight until 3:00 pm (first flight). Boats will be sent out in 50 boat flights and check-in time for weigh-in will be spread 15 minutes apart. Boats will leave by Flight Card in order of registration.
7. Contestants will wear life jacket approved by the U.S. Coast Guard and will have a kill switch attached anytime the main motor is running above idle speed.
8. All Alabama Water Safety Laws and Alabama Game and Fish Regulations will be followed.
9. No alcoholic beverages will be allowed in the boat during the tournament.
10. No trolling, jiggerpoling, fishing outside of the boat, live bait, or fishing within 50 yards of another boat or marina. All site fish must be hooked inside the mouth.
11. Tournament Officials have the right to disqualify questionable fish. All live fish will be returned to the water after weigh-in.
12. Five (5) fish limit (large mouth, small mouth, red eyes and spots only) per boat. Fish must be 12 inches long on golden rule tournament board. There will be a 4 oz. penalty per dead fish.
13. Tournament Officials will resolve any condition arising which is not covered by these rules. Their decisions are FINAL.
14. Ties between first place contestants will be broken first by number of fish, then by the biggest fish. All other ties will be split evenly between the teams.
15. All prize winners are subject to a polygraph test given by a licensed tester and contestants must pass to win.
16. Should inclement weather arise, please take appropriate action for your safety.
17. Anyone under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult and are considered minors.
